COMMUNITY CONCERNS:

Commissioner Bryan reported that the County Commissioners want to vote on the water desalinization program.

The Fletcher Companies project was voted down by Ken Bryan. The project promised 50-60,000 jobs but had no investment for water. It would up to the County to figure that out.

Commissioner Bryan also voted down a diagonal commercial piece of land off State Road 207 which in his opinion is too close to the school where kids are picked up.

Amendment 4 will be voted on in November 2010. Builders are trying to get projects approved now in case Amendment 4 passes.

The sand rejuvenation program set for A1A South St. Augustine. There is talk about the project going to Vilano instead.

Jerry Cameron from the County discussed the Oil Spill and advised that the County already has developed a contingency plan in case the oil around the tip of Florida and up the Atlantic Coast. It is unlikely it will reach us. We are not getting either State or Federal aid at this time to do the contingency program.

There is an Administration Budget meeting Tuesday thru Thursday this week from 9-3 each day at the Administration Building which is open to the public.

There is a meeting tonight regarding the proposed Miami to Jacksonville Railroad. They want to locate a station in St. Augustine. Meeting at 5 pm at City Hall.

The noise ordinance regarding Pusser's. Pusser's wanted to be grandfathered in. Planning Board turned them down. Does not look like Pusser's will be grandfathered?

We did not have a Guest Speaker this month.
